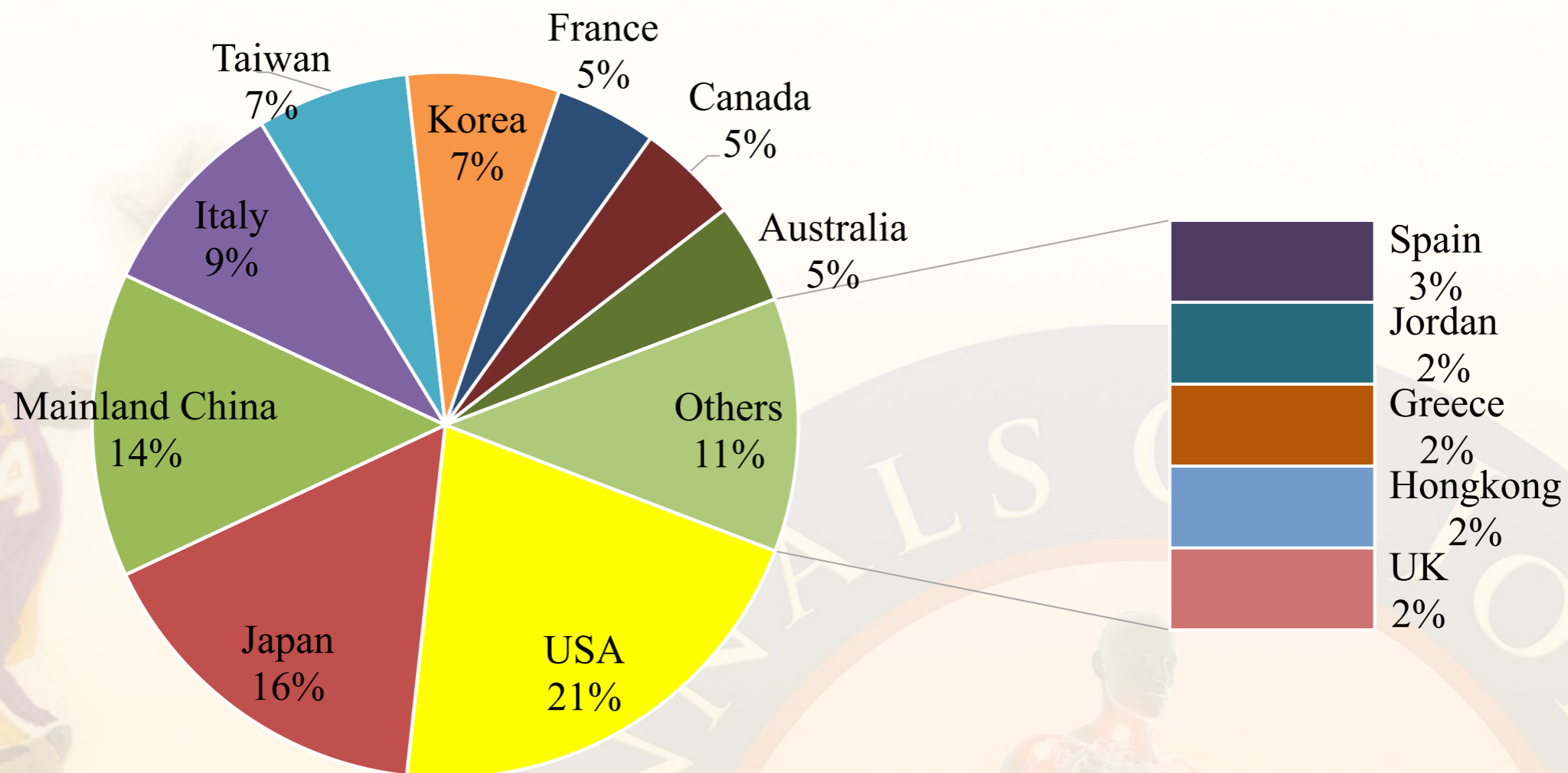

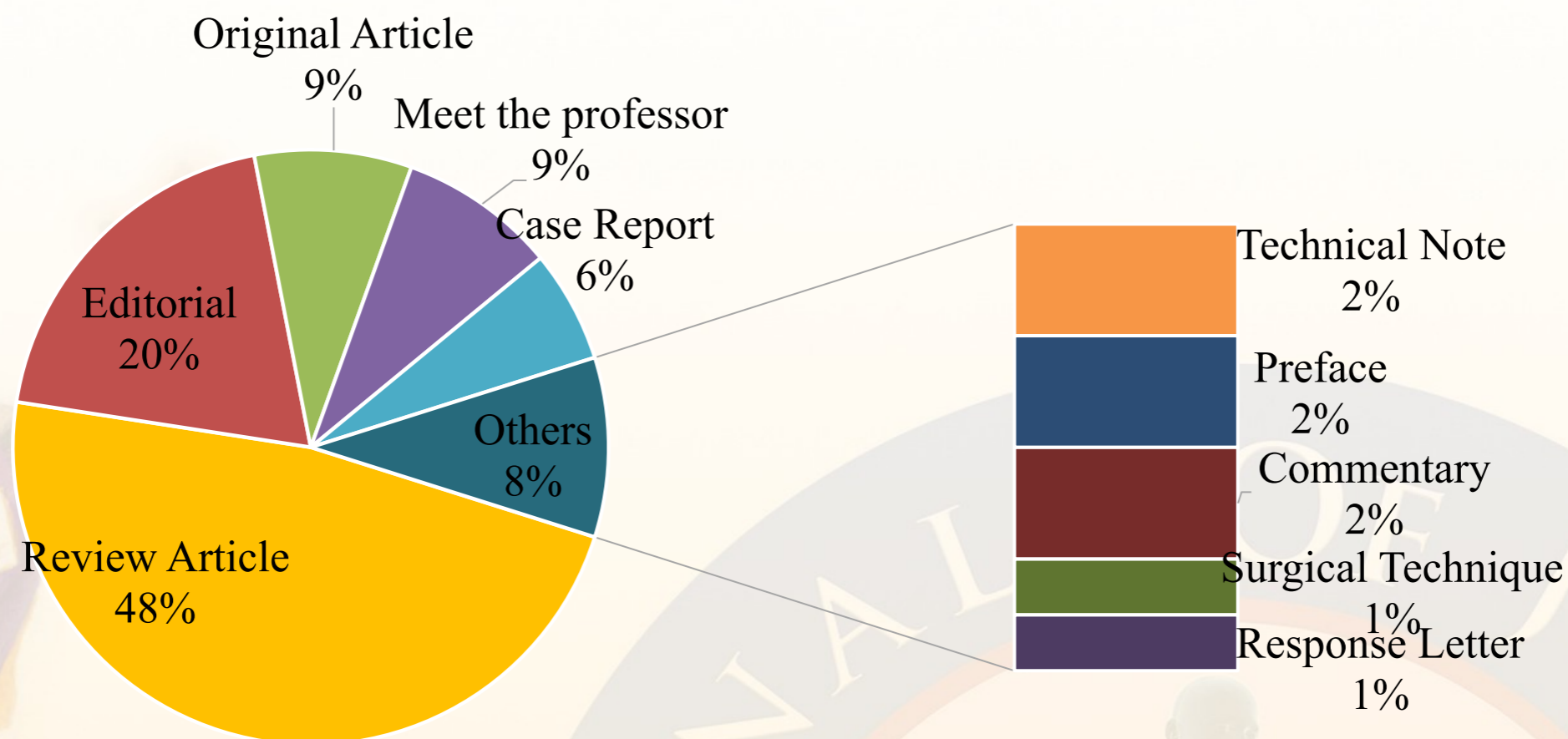


3. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members



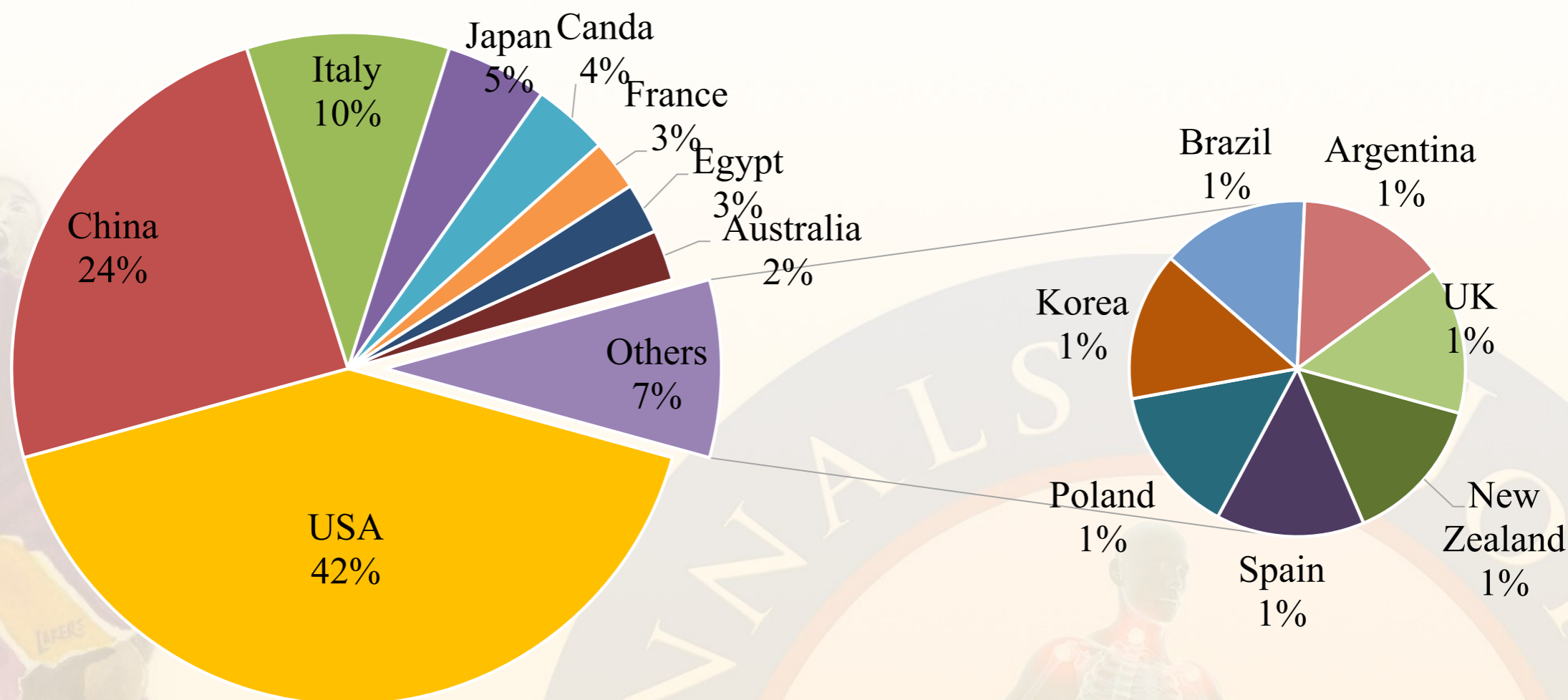
AOJ has **43** Editorial Board Members from **14** countries/regions.

4. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2017



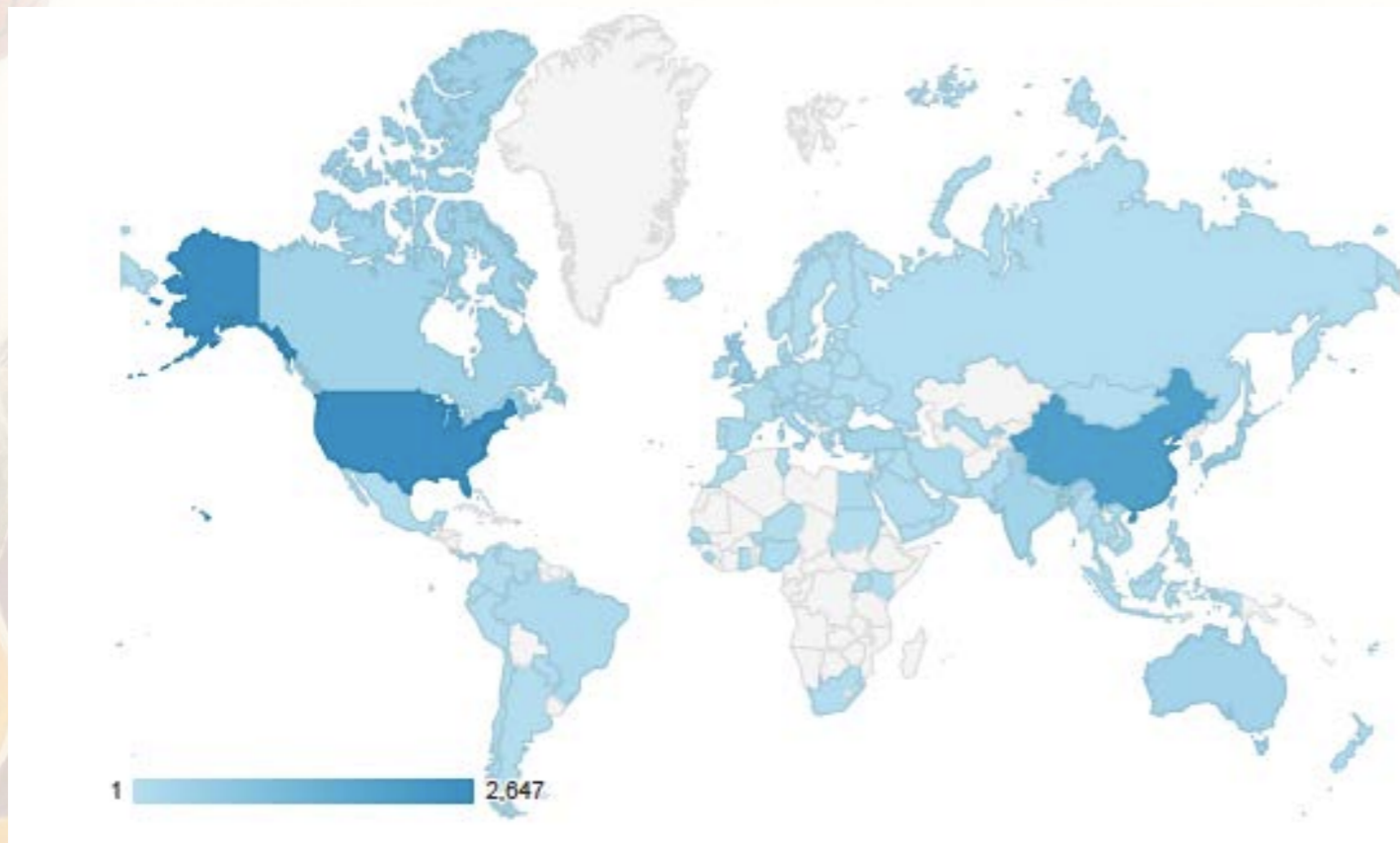
In 2017, AOJ has published **82** articles, among which there are **39** Review Articles, **16** Editorials and **7** Original Articles.
